- Aim: to ensure a smooth progression and satisfactory outcome for the client

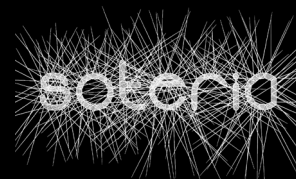
CLAIRE HOGAN BL

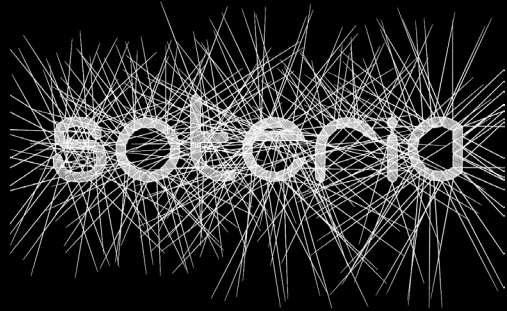
